

## CTTC Information Communication Technology (ICT) Program

### PROGRAM SCHEDULE

The CTTC is holding a series of professional development days dedicated to ICT and its use in the Chinese language classroom. Learn how to use new technologies to create a dynamic and interactive classroom for your students. Participants can register for a single session or all three. Please note that some sessions have limited places, so it is best to register early. No prior knowledge is required for any of the sessions.

#### INTERACTIVE WHITEBOARDS IN THE CHINESE LANGUAGE CLASSROOM

**MONDAY 7<sup>TH</sup> MARCH, 9.30AM - 4.00PM:** Notebook software for a SMARTBoard

**MONDAY 21<sup>ST</sup> MARCH, 9.30AM - 4.00PM:** Easiteach software for a Teamboard

**MONDAY 21<sup>ST</sup> MARCH, 9.30AM - 4.00PM:** ActivInspire software for a Promethean Board

These separate sessions will cater to each type of IWB software. Participants will be guided through a step-by-step journey of examples for listening, speaking, reading and writing activities. Individual examples will be created and shared with the group. Participants must come with the IWB software they use at school loaded on to their laptop.

#### **MONDAY 4<sup>TH</sup> APRIL, 9.30AM - 4.00PM: INTRODUCING IPADS AND IPOD TOUCHES FOR CHINESE**

This session will introduce both the exciting new Apple iPad, and iPod Touch. Participants will have an opportunity to explore several applications for Chinese language as well as some for creating unique digital stories which are useful in helping students to show what they have learned. The iPad and iPod touch equipment will be provided by the CTTC. Please note that places are limited to 16 participants.

#### **MONDAY 23<sup>RD</sup> MAY, 9.30AM - 4.00PM: CREATING PODCASTS FOR CHINESE**

The aim of this workshop is to show participants how to create podcasts that can be used in the Chinese language classroom. Participants will learn how to use Audacity to record and edit audio, including adding music loops and sound effects. Participants will also learn how to put their podcast online to share with others. Examples of teacher and student created podcasts will be provided to help guide participants through the creation process.

### PRESENTER:

#### JESS MCCULLOCH

Jess McCulloch is a pioneer user of ICT in Chinese language teaching and learning from P-12 and is a highly experienced Chinese teacher educator. She has also combined using other technologies such as mobile phones with an interactive whiteboard. Jess created the Seven Wonders of the Whiteboard Challenge (<http://whiteboardchallenge.wikispaces.com>) and contributed a short case study to Chris Betcher and Mal Lee's book *The Interactive Whiteboard Revolution*. Jess has been running ICT/ IWB workshops for the CTTC, and is conducting research into using authentic web based resources in Chinese school programs.
